TODAY IN CHIEFSVILLE...

The Blockade of City Point: The Syracuse offense has been stellar of late, especially in the first two games against Norfolk. The Chiefs posted 13 more hits yesterday, and now have 41 hits over the last three games. Syracuse has posted a .347 team average (41-118), and complied 13 multi-hit games (De Aza 3x, Dominguez 3x, Falu 3x, Sanchez 2x, Almanzar, Bautista).

We Must Preserve This Offense: Irving Falu has seven hits in the last three games, with three consecutive multi-hit games. Fall now holds a career .284 average in 126 games in his Syracuse career...Chris Dominguez has three straight multi-hit games and hits in four in a row. Dominguez leads the Chiefs so far with seven RBIs...Adrian Sanchez tallied his first four hit game Thursday since 2014 when he was a member of the Potomac Nationals.

Hail to the Chief: Alejandro De Aza found three more hits yesterday, and continues his outstanding start to the 2018 season. Over a six-game hitting streak, De Aza is 12 for his last 22 (.545) with six RBIs and seven runs scored. That includes a three game stretch where De Aza is 8-for-11 with three walks since turning 34 on Wednesday. In 64 games as a Chief dating back to last season, De Aza is hitting .298 with a .406 on-base percentage.

Our American Cousin: Edwin Jackson gets the ball for the Chiefs today, making his sixth career appearance in Chiefs' red, white and blue. Jackson held a 0.44 ERA in four Syracuse starts last season, before his contract was selected and he remained in the Nationals rotation for the final two and a half months of the season. Jackson walked six batters on a freezing cold and windy day in Rochester Monday night, his most walks since his eight walks in his no-hit performance in 2010. The 15-year MLB veteran was part of a Chiefs Opening Day Roster that had combined for over 2,200 games of MLB experience.


A. Adams: Austin Adams has has allowed just one hit and not allowed a run in three and one-third innings pitched, leading a Chiefs bullpen that after struggling a bit against the RailRiders, has been strong ever since...Syracuse's pen has pitched to a 1.69 ERA in the last five games, allowing just four earned run in 21 and one-third innings... Carlos Torres has not allowed a run or a hit in his first four innings with the Chiefs...Tim Collins has not not allowed a run or a hit over his last three innings...

Reconciliation: After piloting the 2011 Chiefs, Randy Knorr is back in Syracuse as manager in 2018. Knorr spent four seasons as the Nationals MLB Bench Coach (2012-15) under Davey Johnson and Matt Williams and two as Special Advisor to the GM (2016-17) in between his stints as manager in Syracuse. Knorr is also a former Chiefs player, having suited up for Syracuse as a member of the Blue Jays organization. Knorr spent parts of four seasons with the Chiefs (1991-92, 95-96), totaling 182 games.

Baseball Of the People, By the People, For the People: Chiefs OF Victor Robles left Monday night's game diving for a ball in right-center field. He was played on the Disabled List today, retroactive to April 10th...Syracuse sits in first place for a third day in a row, holding at least a share of the top spot for multiple days for the first time since May 12-13, 2016...Over the last six games, Syracuse has stranded 65 runners on base, holding its opponents to a .125 average with runners in scoring position (9-72).

Jackson Notes...

- Returned to the Nationals organization last season after having started 31 games for the NL East Champs in 2012. Started 2017 in Norfolk before joining the Orioles as a relief pitcher. Signed with the Nationals on June 16th and moved back to rotation. Posted a 0.44 ERA in four starts with the Chiefs before spending the rest of the season in Washington's rotation. Combined to post a 1.77 ERA in 13 Triple-A games (6 starts) between Norfolk and Syracuse last year.
- Has pitched in 15 MLB seasons for 12 different teams (LAD, TB, DET, ARI, CWS, STL, WSH, CHC, ATL, MIA, SD, BAL), tied for the second most in history (w/Mike Morgan, Ron Villone and Matt Stairs, Octavio Dotel pitched for 13). Has not thrown an entire season as a starter since 2014 w/CHI Cubs.
- Has been traded six times in career, including in the December 2009 deal that sent Max Scherzer to Detroit. Other players traded in deals involving Jackson include Curtis Granderson, Austin Jackson, Phil Coke, Ian Kennedy, Daniel Hudson, Octavio Dotel, and Colby Rasmus.
- Has thrown in nine career postseason games, including in two World Series games (2008 w/TB and 2011 w/STL). Posted a 5.60 ERA in four postseason starts for 2011 World Champion Cardinals. Was also named a 2009 American League All-Star with Detroit (3.62 ERA in 33 starts that season).
- Threw a no-hitter on June 25th for Diamondbacks against former team (Rays) in 1-0 win. Threw 149 pitches that day, and walked eight batters (both still career highs). Had walked seven and thrown 70 pitches through just three innings. Later that year became first pitcher to throw a no-hitter and get traded in the same season since 1951 (Cliff Chambers).
- Made his MLB debut with the Dodgers on September 9, 2003 (his 20th birthday) against the Diamondbacks and Randy Johnson. Threw six innings of one-run ball, posting four strikeouts.
- Originally a sixth round selection of the Dodgers in 2001. Was drafted as an outfielder, before being converted to a pitcher as a pro (scouts noticed his arm as he threw out baserunners from centerfield). Was named the Dodgers 2002 Minor League Player of the Year and pitched in the 2003 Futures Game
- Father, Edwin Sr., is a retired United State Army Sergeant First Class. Worked as a U.S. Army cook. Edwin, Jr. was born in Neu-Ulm, West Germany while father was stationed at Nelson Kaserne (base closed 1991 following Cold War). Jackson is one of 27 players born in Germany to play in Major Leagues.
- Spent three of first eight years of his life in Germany, spent rest of his youth in Columbus, GA.


