### TODAY IN CHIEFSVILLE...

**Offensive Notes:** **José Marmolejos** is 23x67 (.333) with a home run, three doubles, and 15 RBIs over his last 18 games since August 14th. Last night, Marmolejos was 2-for-4 with an RBI. Marmolejos has hits in five straight games and eight of the last nine, including multiple hits in five of the last nine games.  
 - According to Fangraphs, **Yadiel Hernandez** has hit the ball the opposite way 39.9% of the time with Syracuse. Hernandez has hit a career-high 18 home runs this season, combined between Double-A Harrisburg (7 HR) and Syracuse (11 HR). Hernandez is 17x55 (.309) with two home runs, a double, seven RBIs, and seven walks over his last 16 games since August 15th.  
 - **Bengie Gonzalez** is 16-for-48 (.333) with four doubles, a home run, six RBIs, and three walks over his last 15 games.  
 - **Chris Dominguez** is 28x99 (.283) with 12 runs scored, seven doubles, three home runs and 21 RBIs over his last 27 games since July 27th.  
 - **Irving Falu** has the best total plate appearances/strikeout ratio in the league at 13.13.

**Starting Strong:** Over the last 32 games, Chiefs starting pitchers have posted a 2.93 ERA (181 IP, 59 ER). Excluding one start in game two of a doubleheader on August 4 (Darnell 10 ER/3.1 IP), Syracuse starting pitchers have posted a 2.48 ERA (177.2 IP/49 ER) in the other 31 games.

**Offensive Outburst:** Over the last 21 games the Chiefs are 13-8. In the 13 wins, Syracuse is averaging 6.3 runs and 12.1 hits per game. In the eight losses, the Chiefs are averaging 1.5 runs and 6.5 hits. This season, Syracuse is 33-6 when scoring more than five runs in a game (April: 5-0, May: 9-4, June: 2-1, July: 8-1, August: 8-0, September: 1-0). The Chiefs have scored at least six runs in nine of their last 21 games.

**Hit Parade:** The Chiefs have out-hit opponents in 13 of the last 15 games since August 18th, out-hitting opponents, 158-104 over that span, averaging 10.5 hits versus 6.9 for opponents. (10-5 record).

**Ace McGowin:** Kyle McGowin continued his stellar run with seven innings of one-run ball and six strikeouts on Wednesday. In seven starts with Syracuse, McGowin has a 1.32 ERA in 47.2 IP with 25 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 9 BB, and 39 K.

**Best of the Best:** The Chiefs hold a 22-14 record over their last 36 games since July 27th. That mark is the second-best record in the I.L. since that date...

**RISPY Business:** Syracuse went 3-for-12 with runners in scoring position last night. Over the last 67 games, the Chiefs are 33-34. In the 33 wins, the Chiefs have hit .326 (121x371) w/RISP. But Syracuse has gone just 34-for-228 (.149) w/RISP in the 34 losses.

**Prospect Hot Sheet:** Victor Robles on a seven-game hitting streak, has hits in 12 of his last 15 games, and has reached base in 15 consecutive games. Robles is 23x64 (.359) over his last 15 games with six doubles, a triple, a three-run home run, four RBIs, five walks, and nine runs scored since August 18th. Robles, the Nats top ranked prospect and sixth-ranked prospect in baseball (per Baseball America) was activated off the DL on July 27th. Robles spent three-and-a-half months on the DL after he was injured attempting to make a diving catch in center field on April 9th. Since coming off the DL, Robles leads the league with 12 stolen bases. Overall, the Chiefs are 23-16 in the 39 games Robles has played this year, including 21-13 since his return on July 27th.

**Comeback Cuse:** The Chiefs overcame a 2-0 deficit in the first inning last night. Syracuse have been kings of the comeback and late-inning rallies recently. Of Syracuse's 22 wins since July 27th, it has come from behind in 11 of the 22, and the Chiefs have won the game when it was tied in the final inning in two others. Of the 11 comebacks, eight have been from at least two runs down, three from at least four down, and Syracuse came back from seven runs down on July 30th at Pawtucket.

**Staying Close:** Over the last 18 games, when Syracuse has trailed on the scoreboard, it has held its opponents to a .192 batting average against (28x146).

**Best of August:** Syracuse posted the I.L.'s best ERA in August at 3.06... Syracuse also leads the league in stolen bases since August 1st with 25.

**Getting Your Money's Worth:** Syracuse is tied with Rochester with a league-high 18 extra-inning games played. Syracuse has a 10-8 record in extra-inning games (fifth best win percentage in the I.L.).

**Been Caught Stealing:** Pedro Severino has thrown out 28% of runners attempting a steal with Syracuse this year (8x29). With Washington, Severino threw out 34% of runners (14x41). Tuffy Gosewisch has thrown out 33% of runners attempting a steal with him behind the plate this season (16x48).

**By the Numbers:** Syracuse is tied for fourth in the I.L. in batting average at .256, and is tied for second in OBP (.325). Syracuse is fourth in hits (1,178), third in walks (448) and has struck out 37 fewer times than any other I.L. team (998). (SYR has struck out 284 fewer times than Columbus). Syracuse is tied for second in the league in average with RISP at .267. Syracuse is 11th in runs scored (563) and 11th in runs scored per game (4.05). The Chiefs have hit the fewest and allowed the third fewest HRs in the league (78 hit, 96 allowed).

**Chiefs in the Show:** C Pedro Severino was recalled by Washington Saturday and RHP Austen Williams had his contract selected for the first time. Severino finished his time with Syracuse on a nine-game hitting streak. During the streak, Severino went 17x37 (.459) with a home run, two doubles, and five RBIs, posting multiple hits in six of nine games. His .459 batting average from August 18th to August 30th led the league. Williams combined to post a 1.19 ERA in 32 MiLB games between Syracuse and Harrisburg, including a 0.55 ERA in eight games with the Chiefs.

Including one rehabber (Grace), 24 players have been on both Syracuse and Washington's rosters this year. Williams will be the 36th former Chief to appear on the Nats 2018 roster:

**Syracuse combines for first no-hitter in 18 years**

On April 18th, Austin Voth, David Goforth, Tim Collins and Austin Adams combined to throw the 17th no-hitter in Syracuse baseball history in a 5-0, seven-inning win in game one of a doubleheader against Indianapolis. It was the first no-hitter thrown by Syracuse since Leo Estrella threw a seven-inning perfect game on June 17, 2000, also against the Indians.



**Field Manager:  
 #40 Randy Knorr**

Knorr returns as Chiefs manager in 2018 after piloting Syracuse in 2011. Knorr spent four seasons (2012-2015) as the Nationals MLB bench coach under managers Davey Johnson and Matt Williams

- Seventh season as a MiLB manager, all in WSH system (Syracuse '11, Harrisburg '10, Potomac '06-'08), Savannah '05)
- Also served as Nationals Bullpen Coach in 2009 and end of 2006
- Spent last two years as Senior Advisor to the General Manager
- Played in parts of 19 pro seasons (11 in Blue Jays system including for SYR in '91-'92, '95-'96). Hit .226 in 253 Major League games with Toronto, Houston, Florida, Texas and Montreal



**Hitting/3B Coach:  
 #47 Brian Daubach**

Daubach is back for his third season as Chiefs hitting coach and first as full time third base coach (coached third in NL games the last two years). Daubach was previous a manager in the WSH system

- Spent previous five seasons as manager in Nats system before time with the Chiefs (Harrisburg '14-'15, Potomac '13, Hagerstown '11-12)
- Played in 661 Major League games, hitting .259 with 93 HR, 139 2B, and 333 RBI with Florida ('98), Boston ('99-'02, '04), CHI White Sox ('03), NY Mets ('05)



**Pitching Coach:  
 #38 Brad Holman**

Holman is in his first year in the Nationals organization after spending the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers Bullpen Coach under Jeff Banister. 2018 is his 17th as a professional coach

- Holman spent the previous seven season as a pitching coach in the Texas system before his two-year run as bullpen coach
- Has made stops as pitching coach in Round Rock ('13-'15), Myrtle Beach ('11-'12), Hickory ('09-'10), Altoona ('08), West Tennessee ('07), San Antonio ('06) and Wisconsin ('02-'05)
- Pitched in seven professional seasons, including in 19 games for the Mariners in 2003

He was throwing all three pitches for strikes. He was commanding the baseball. I was telling him, 'Try to know what kind of pitcher you are.' He had good location. His slider was working as an out pitch. He made a lot of improvement through the AFL, but the main thing for him was commanding his pitches."
- Started 2017 w/Syracuse, posted 6.31 ERA over nine starts; reassigned to Double-A on June 16th, pitched to 6.54 in eight starts. on Disabled List 7/13-8/21. After coming off DL, had a 1.93 ERA over final three starts with Senators (17 K, 4 BB, 18.2 IP).
- Traded with RHP Austin Adams from the Angels to the Nationals for infielder Danny Espinosa on December 10, 2016
- Ranked as the Angels 22nd-best prospect after the 2016 season by Baseball America before being traded to the Nationals
- Drafted by the Los Angeles Angels in the 5th round in 2013...Highest drafted player in Savannah State history. Posted 128 strikeouts his junior year at SSU, ranked second in Division 1.


